


DFW leads all US airports with 259 total destinations

Destinations for major US airports (YE July 2024)





Strong performance FYTD, averaging 9.6% growth YoY








Mexico represents the largest market for all international passengers









September passenger projection (in thousands)




DFW terminal split by hour – Sep 2024







Travelers navigating the Airport seek a variety of food options while managing their limited time. They need to understand what is available to them while feeling calm, assured, and in control.




Traveler purchase behaviors are largely influenced by whether the options were worth the money and if they had enough time to make a purchase.

Traveler Dwell Time (Minutes) by Concessions Purchase Behavior




Travelers who make an F&B purchase generally require longer dwell times than those who do not.

For those dining at a sitdown restaurant, the average dwell time exceeds 3 hours.

Sit-Down restaurant Purchase Barriers Study. Sample Size: 200. Q: Today, how many minutes did you have in the terminal where you could shop, eat, work or relax prior to boarding your flight out of DFW?. Q: Today, did you make a purchase at a sit-down restaurant at DFW Airport? (i.e., a restaurant where you order from the table or with wait staff) Q: Did you purchase from any food/beverage location, including vending machines, today at DFW Airport?





Based on data from DFW's customer satisfaction study, traveler dwell times have been trending downward since 2019.





How did you order your Food & Beverage?



Therefore, about two-thirds of passengers choose to take their food and beverages togo, either through take-out or graband-go options.





More than half of the travelers are also watching their spending at the Airport, making them more price-sensitive.


2024 Airport Experience Research












RAC Gross Receipts FYTD through June

FY24 gross receipts are projected to be up 6.2% vs FY23, up 16.4% vs FY22








FY25 Destination Passenger Budget vs FY24 Outlook

FY25 Destination Passengers are projected to 1.5M up 3.3% vs FY24, up 9.5% vs FY23








FY25 RAC Gross Receipts Budget vs FY24 Outlook


FY25 Gross Receipts projected to be up 0.2% vs FY24, up 6.4% vs FY23





F&B/Retail Concessions Gross Receipts (Oct – Jun) Actuals


Gross receipts are up 13% in FY24 vs FY23





Total Concessions Gross Receipts


FY25 Gross Receipts are forecasted to grow by 5%
