Phase Out of Single-use Plastics For Concessions Locations

Elimination of plastic straws for concessions locations will go into effect September 16, 2019.

In support of DFW Airport's commitment to sustainability, effective September 16, 2019, single-use **plastic** straws will no longer be permitted in concessions locations at DFW Airport.



DFW Airport is a part of a greater whole within our industry and community; we will work collaboratively with our stakeholders and partners to implement the innovation and change necessary to protect our natural resources and allow future generations to thrive.

Concessionaires should provide a naturally degradable straw of their choice, such as paper, seaweed or natural grain, to distribute to customers **upon request**. More on plastic straw alternatives can be found <u>here</u>. DFW Airport will assist you in finding an alternative. You may contact <u>Kris Russell</u> or <u>James Alford</u> for assistance.

Concessionaires will be able to sell eco-friendly multi-use alternatives to plastic straws such as silicone and reusable cups with attached straws. All locations are encouraged to accept customers reusable cups for beverage purchases.

DFW Marketing will distribute signs that can be placed at each location explaining DFW Airport's new eco-friendly initiative, and word will be spread through our partners in social media.

Staff from the DFW Airport Environmental Affairs Department will attend the **Concessions Forum on September 13th** to speak about the positive effects DFW's actions will have on the Airport and our environment. Single Use Plastic Straw Phase Out Q&A

1) What is the single-use plastic phase-out?

DFW Airport, in partnership with our concessionaires and business partners, will phase out all single use plastic straws in all five terminals.

1) When will plastic straws be phased out?

The phase out will begin mid-September but we do expect for it to take a bit of time for the straws to be eliminated, this initiative will be a major adjustment given that we currently use more than 4.25 million annually!

2) Why is the airport phasing out plastic straws?

- a. At DFW we see ourselves as environmental stewards and work continually to find new ways to reduce our environmental footprint. That's why we are taking steps to remove single-use plastic straws from our terminals.
- b. Plastic straws are not recyclable and cause contamination in DFW's recycling stream. They persist in the environment and often end up in our oceans and waterways.
- c. As part of our local community and the greater aviation industry we are working collaboratively with our stakeholders and partners on this program to implement the innovation and change necessary to protect our natural resources and allow future generations to thrive.
- d. DFW Airport has a goal to achieve Zero Waste (90% diversion from landfill). To achieve this goal, we are pursuing alternatives for materials that cannot be recycled.

3) Will alternatives be offered?

a. DFW Airport is encouraging all of our concessionaires and business partners to offer a naturally biodegradable or compostable straw of their choice to customers upon request.



b. Alternates could include paper straws or straws made from organic materials.

4) Will there be more changes in the future?

As we move toward a Zero Waste goal of 90% diversion from landfill, DFW Airport will explore more ways to reduce our environmental impact.

5) What about those with disabilities who need a straw?

Exceptions will be provided for those with disabilities.
